Part 2: Pricing Tips for Nigerian Freelancers

1. **Start With Entry-Level Rates** if you're a beginner, but raise them as your skills grow.
 - Writing: ~~₦3000~~ - ~~₦10,000~~ per 500-1000 words
 - Graphic Design: ~~₦5,000~~ - ~~₦20,000~~ per project
 - Social Media Management: ~~₦20,000~~ - ~~₦75,000~~/month
 - Web Design: ~~₦40,000~~ - ~~₦150,000~~+
2. **Bill Per Project or Monthly** instead of hourly to avoid undercharging.
3. **Always Collect a 50% Deposit Upfront.** This protects you from client ghosting.
4. **Charge in Dollars** when possible if you're working with international clients. Use PayPal, Wise, or Payoneer.
5. **Review and Adjust Your Rates** every 3-6 months as you gain experience.

Even if you don't have clients yet, build a strong sample portfolio using the following tips:

For Writers:

- Write 2-3 sample blog posts or landing pages
- Save in Google Docs or create a Notion portfolio

For Designers:

- Design logos, flyers, or mockup social media posts
- Upload to Behance or Dribbble

For Web Developers:

- Build demo websites using templates or imaginary brands

- Host on Netlify, GitHub Pages, or create a simple portfolio site

For Other Freelancers (VAs, Editors, etc.):

- Create "Before & After" samples
- Take screenshots of dashboard work (blur private data)
- Write a case study of how you'd help a business

Canva (For visual portfolio items)

Notion (Build a sleek, one-page portfolio)

Behance / Dribbble / Contently (for creatives)

Part 2: Pricing Tips

- **Don't undersell yourself!** Here are tips for setting fair freelance rates in Nigeria:
- **Start simple:** Charge based on skill, time, and value.
- **Hourly Rate (for consultations or ongoing work):** ~~₦3,000–₦10,000+~~
- **Per Project (web design, writing, etc.):** Start from ~~₦20,000~~ depending on scope.
- **Monthly Retainers (social media, SEO, etc.):** ~~₦50,000–₦300,000+~~
- **International Clients:** Charge in dollars via PayPal, Payoneer, or Wise.
- **Always collect 50% upfront** before starting any work.

Part 3: Portfolio Checklist

Even as a beginner, your portfolio shows proof of skill. Make sure it includes:

- ✓ 3–5 quality samples of your work
- ✓ Clear service description (what you do and for whom)
- ✓ Testimonials or mock reviews (even from friends or practice clients)
- ✓ About Me section (your story and background)
- ✓ Contact info (email, WhatsApp, or social media link)
- ✓ Optional: pricing info, frequently asked questions (FAQs)

Where to host it:

- Google Drive (simple, fast)
- Canva (design a one-pager)
- Behance or Dribbble (for creatives)

- Carrd or Notion (for a free one-page portfolio site)
